PROFESSIONAL ACTIVITY OF PARTICIPANTS IN THE EDUCATIONAL PROCESS AND RESEARCHERS DURING THE WAR

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Due to Russia's full-scale invasion of Ukraine, many academic organizations have opened up opportunities for Ukrainian researchers, scholars, and students. Many activities have been organized to support resettlement scholars. This support enables researchers and educational workers to carry out their work and professional activities without hindrance, and to keep in touch with Ukrainian universities and research centers. Academic mobility programs help researchers adapt to difficult conditions, strengthen cooperation of higher education institutions, help researchers gain innovative experience, develop, and continue their professional activities.

It is important to say that the information and propositions of academic mobility programs for students are more common than those of mobility programs for academics. There is ample evidence of this in resources and channels. Often the age limits for program participants are prescribed. It is also important to note the fact that it is difficult for certain universities to sign individual study schedules for students. The student submits a petition stating the reason for transferring to an individual schedule, attaching the supporting documents. It happens that officials at Ukrainian universities may not respond to a student's requests. Such actions of university officials under the circumstances put students at risk, who are forced to return to Ukraine so that they are not expelled from the university. Today it is especially relevant to perform professional activities in more favorable conditions.

It is also necessary to take into account the moral and psychological state of the students, who are particularly negatively affected by being in military conditions without support.

In the Decree of the Cabinet of Ministers of Ukraine (from August 12, 2015 N_{2} 579 Kiev) On approval of the procedure for implementing the right to academic mobility the key aspects are the right to participate in academic mobility programs for all participants in the educational process; preservation of place of study and scholarship for students and place of work for employees of universities participating in academic mobility programs.

Unfortunately, some educational institutions forget about it, do not take into account the security situation. Mostly, those educational institutions ignore security measures, the management of which believes that the institution is located in the safer territory of Ukraine.

Let us return to the academic mobility provisions for researchers, and today these provisions are many times fewer than those for students. Although in Ukrainian higher education institutions participation in mobility programs is one of the main conditions for passing the contract, along with the publication of research results in the publications of other countries.

It is worth paying attention to the international departments of higher educational institutions in Ukraine to simplify the submission of applications for participation in academic mobility programs for students. This is because such programs contribute to the development of professional skills and the expansion of international ties, which benefits society.

Thus, academic mobility plays a major role in the development of professionalism of participants in the educational process of various areas of activity. The organization of academic mobility is designed to establish integration links, improve the quality of scientific and educational results, update scientific research on the basis of international experience, and also helps to develop communicative competence.

In addition, the problems of education and research during war have already been predicted. It is important not to violate the rights of participants in educational processes and researchers, but to develop ways to solve these problems.
